

Financial Information

Each patient has unique needs, and therefore the surgical procedure is individualized for you. Therefore the cost of surgery is different for each patient. In order to get the most accurate sense of pricing we ask that patients come into the practice for a consultation with Dr. Kpodzo. During the consultation Dr. Kpodzo will discuss with you your goals and expectations, examine you and formulate the best treatment plan for you.

Insurance Coverage

Most cosmetic plastic surgery procedures are not covered by health insurance. For cases that are reconstructive in nature, our staff will help you determine your insurance eligibility, in these cases your health insurance may cover a portion of or the complete cost of your reconstructive surgery. Procedures which are typically considered reconstructive include:

- **Breast reduction:** for relief of significant neck, shoulder and back pain resulting from large heavy breasts
- **Breast reconstruction:** for reconstruction of the breast following mastectomy and for creating symmetry in the unaffected breast
- **Skin cancer:** removal of skin cancer and reconstruction for closure
- **Keloids:** surgical and non-surgical treatment of keloids

Plastic Surgery Fees

What is included in the fees?

When you receive the estimate of your surgical fees it will include the following:

Surgeon's fee

Anesthesia Fee

Facility Fee (covers the operating room time and any supplies that are used, and special equipment which is needed)

Overnight Suite Fee (if an overnight stay in the hospital is required)

Implants

Post-surgical garments (bra, post liposuction garments etc.)

Surgery Date Reservation Fee

Once you have decided to move forward with surgery a non-refundable deposit of \$500 is required to reserve your surgery date and time. If you must cancel your surgery, you must do so 2 weeks (14 days) prior to your date of surgery in order for your full reservation fee to be applied at a later date (up to one (1) year).

Payment for Cosmetic Surgery Procedures

Payment is due in full two weeks (14 days) prior to the date of your procedure. Botox® and filler (such as Restylane, Juvederm, Belatero) procedures must be paid for on the date of service.

Method of Payment

We accept payment via credit card, cash, or certified check and Care Credit. We do not accept personal checks.
