

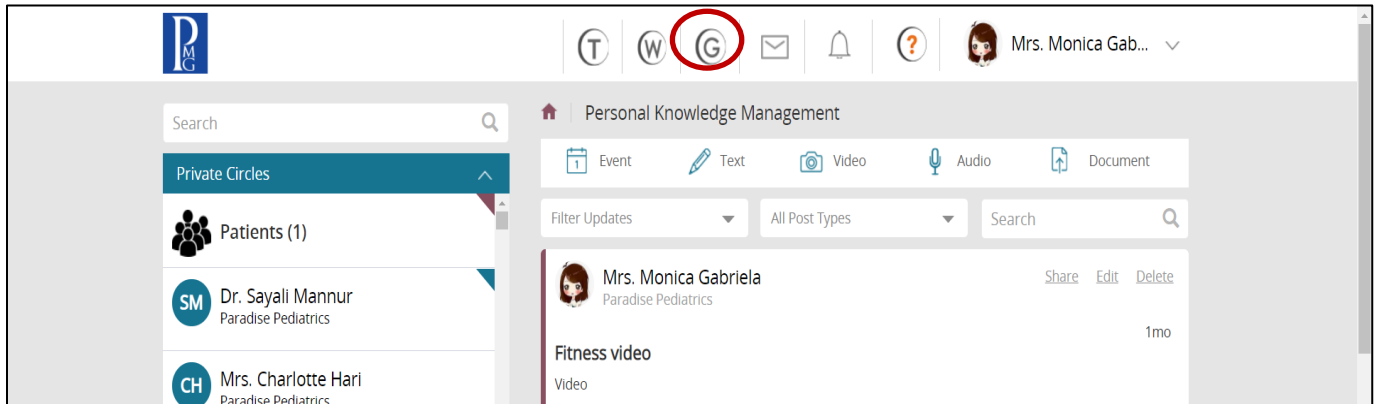

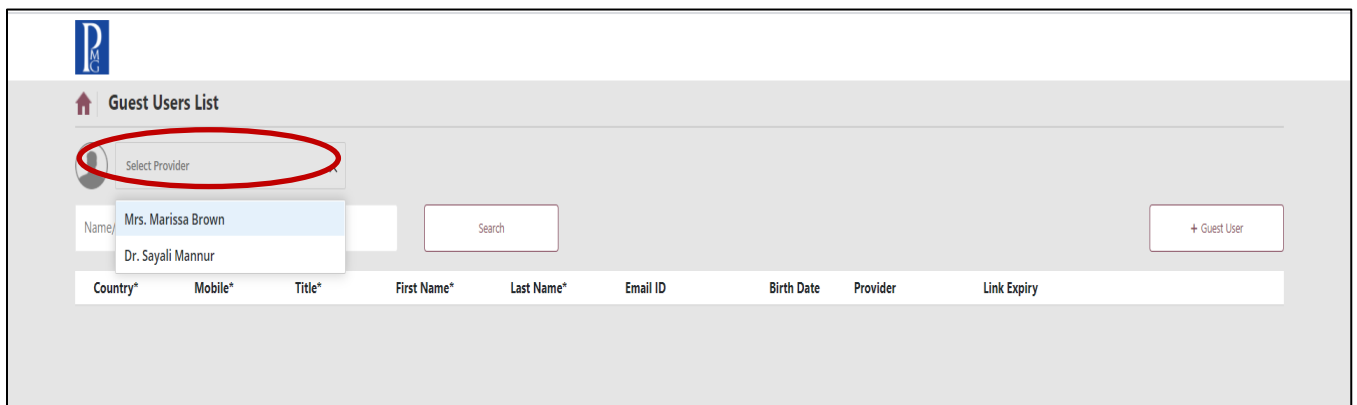

Virtual Call for Guest Patients -Custom Link for Providers

Step 1: Click on G to create Guest User Custom URL
